



Scholarships and Financial Assistance

The Leadership for Learning program covers the cost of most instructional materials, including books. In addition, the program offers annual needs-based awards to students in good standing. During the 2013-2014 academic year, 15 cohort members received funding, with an average award over \$4,000. Additional opportunities, including travel stipends, may be available.

Estimated Program Costs for L4L Cohort 5

Leadership for Learning is a self-sustaining (fee-based) program. A budget is prepared each year based on actual costs. Generally, students can anticipate a modest increase each year to coincide with university-wide tuition increases. Tuition rates are set each June for the upcoming academic year. This is an **estimate only** based on current tuition rates.
