Personal History Statement	Optional statement if you wish to provide any additional information about your personal background.
Endorsement Evaluation Form	Completed by <u>UW subject advisor</u>
2 letters of recommendation	Detailing academic potential, leadership, collaboration, adaptability. Applicants will list a minimum of 2 recommenders in the online application. Recommenders will receive a link to submit their letter online.

Unofficial transcripts	Unofficial transcripts are required from all schools attended in the last 5 years and all schools in which a degree was earned. Transcripts should be uploaded to the application. International transcripts must be in English and provide degree verification. It is not required to have your transcripts evaluated by a service.
Basic Skills Assessment	Reading, Writing, and Math subtests must be taken by the application deadline. WEST-B, ACT, SAT, CBEST or Praxis I scores can be used. Score reports should be uploaded to the application if official scores were not sent to the UW. No minimum passing score is required.

The following requirements must be completed before the program begins March 2026.

Endorsement coursework	All endorsement courses must be completed before starting the program.
Bachelor's degree completed	Bachelor's degree must be conferred before starting the MIT.
Oral and Written ACTFL – WORLD LANGUAGE CANDIDATES ONLY	World Language candidates must achieve at least Advanced Low on both the Oral and Written ACTFL in the target language. Scores may be submitted with the application but passing scores are not required for the application review. Both exams must be passed prior to the start of the MIT.
